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Parent and Child Code of Conduct

As per of your contract with HopeForYou childcare, the daycare reserve the right to withdraw or deny services if it is believed that the particular needs of your child or family cannot be appropriately met. All children (school age) and parents are required to sign this document at the time of registration and when revised. The decision for suspension or withdrawal will be based on, but not limited to the following types of incidents:

- Extreme physical acts against other children or provider (hitting, biting, or any other form of physical threat or assault).
- Non compliance of staff's direction; including a child who leaves the daycare premises without permission and/or leave the care of the daycare's Provider on or offsite...
- Verbal attacks on other children, provider, or children's family, which includes the use of threats, name calling, as well as repeated profane or degrading language.
- Racial or other discriminatory comments
- Repeat incidents of Lying, stealing or vandalizing of other children's properties or the daycare's,

HopeForYou understands that occurrences of misunderstanding and conflict will occur among children; therefore, this is not intended to over manage normal incidents that assist children in acquiring problem solving skills. Each child needs vary in terms of environment and program; and so, some children may not benefit from the program offered through our home care family settings. If a child's behavior is related to a diagnosed developmental concern, we will work with the assistance of outside resources to best meet the needs of that child. However, if upon an assessment we have identified that for the child's best interest a withdrawal from our program is needed, the agency Director will assist the parents through the process, making it a smooth and successful one.
